Through concise description and analysis, the authors of the book –Subhash C. Jain and Ben L. Kedia- address a wide variety of topics to understand the progress of India since its independence till the leadership of PM Narendra Modi: from the situation of the country when the colonial rule ended up, the post-independence problems (integration of princely states, migrants from Pakistan) and 1991 economic reforms and liberalization as well as their impact on economic growth, to the current scenario of the country under the government of PM Narendra Modi and the needs to boost jobs and economic growth for well-being and prosperity in India

The book will help readers to have the big picture of the major developments in India from its independence on 14 August 1947 to 2017. This knowledge and insights will shed light on the current and emerging challenges of Prime Minister Narendra Modi –after his landslide re-election victory in May 2019- to grasp opportunities for India in the global economy in the next 5 years (2019-2024).

The audience of the book includes many stakeholders: academics and students in the field of economy and business in the Indian subcontinent and Asia; CEOs, policymakers, government staff as well as general readers interested in India and its development since the independence in 1947.
